

Action Report

Teachers Feedback Summary and Response



This report summarizes the feedback gathered from teachers for the session 2023-24 which outline the key actions to be taken in response to their comments and suggestions. This will help enhance teaching practices, improve the learning environment, and support teacher development.

Summary of Feedback

Teachers provided feedback in various areas including curriculum, classroom management, resources, student engagement, and professional development. The following are the main themes identified from their feedback:

- Teachers suggested that the curriculum be more flexible to accommodate diverse student learning styles and paces. Several educators expressed the need for more hands-on activities and real-world applications to engage students.

- Many teachers expressed a desire for ongoing professional development opportunities, particularly in areas like technology integration, differentiated instruction, and assessment strategies.

Action Plan

- Review and revise the curriculum to include more flexible teaching strategies, real-world applications, and diverse learning materials.
- Offer additional training on classroom management techniques, particularly focused on maintaining discipline and fostering positive behavior. Explore the possibility of hiring more support staff.
- Conduct an inventory of current resources and identify areas for improvement.
 Begin procurement of updated digital tools and specialized materials as requested.
- Introduce more project-based learning opportunities, collaborative activities, and interactive lessons. Encourage teachers to share successful strategies in staff meetings.
- Develop a comprehensive professional development schedule that includes workshops on technology integration, differentiated instruction, and assessment methods.

The feedback provided by teachers is invaluable in creating a positive and effective teaching environment. By addressing the issues raised and implementing the action plan, we aim to support our educators in their professional growth and enhance the overall learning experience for students.
